

33 Schools in Namsai Onboarded on Hamara Vidyalay App with Support from Sterlite EdIndia Foundation



13 March 2026, Namsai, Arunachal Pradesh: An awareness and culmination event on the **Hamara Vidyalaya App** was organised at the **Multipurpose Cultural Hall, Namsai**, by **Sterlite EdIndia Foundation** to promote effective use of the digital platform for monitoring teacher attendance and tracking student performance across schools in the district.

The event was attended by **Shri C.R. The app allows schools to record teacher attendance and track student marks for report cards, enabling better monitoring of students' annual academic performance.

The programme served as the **Hamara Vidyalaya Appreciation Programme**, recognising schools and educators for their efforts in strengthening academic management and digital adoption in the district.

The programme was hosted by **Smti. Sushila Gurung, DTO, Department of Education, Namsai**, and began with a welcome address and felicitation ceremony by **Smt. Khyati Ved, Chief Manager (Operations), Sterlite EdIndia Foundation**.

Ven. Sivali Bhante, Director, Mahabodhi Lord Buddha College, appreciated Sterlite EdIndia Foundation for signing a **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** with the institution and emphasised the transformative role of education in promoting equality and positive change within communities.
